Student Leadership Policy

Rationale

Leadership programs provide optimum opportunities for students to develop their leadership skills, model school values, and display pride in themselves and the school community.

Aims

- To provide opportunities for students to develop leadership skills
- To provide opportunities for Years 5 and 6 students to build their leadership skills by modelling appropriate behaviour and expectations throughout the school.
- To provide opportunities for Year 5 and 6 students to take on roles of responsibility within the school.

ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Student leaders to have a student voice within the school.
- Are expected to help around the school in areas such as guiding visitors, looking after students assisting a staff member and being generally helpful.
- May be involved in the enrolment and welcome procedures for new students.
- Are responsible for the running of school assemblies, including special events, Flags, Discos and fundraising and any other roles that arise throughout the year.
- Sports Captains organise and running of the sports events, assisting in school sporting teams, handing out sports equipment and monitoring equipment.

PROCEDURES

The election process will occur in in Term 1. Elections will be held in week 2 of term 1 of the school years to ensure all SRC membes are ready to commence their roles.

ELECTION PROCESS

1. Students nominate for the SRC position and have their nomination signed by their parent/guardian.
2. Student willing to nominate for SRC write a speech and present their speech to the Year 2 to 6 students. Parents will be invited to attend.
3. Candidates prepare a short speech to voting body on their attributes and suitability for the role.
4. All students from year 2–6 vote in a secret ballot using 3, 2, 1 listing their preferences.
5. Administration staff with a parent representative to tally results.
6. Leadership team and relevant teachers to make the final decision for the SRC and Head Girl and Head Boy based on the election results, their knowledge of the students and any other factors.
7. The successful candidates are announced at the next Assembly where parents will be invited to attend. Badges will be handed out at this assembly.
